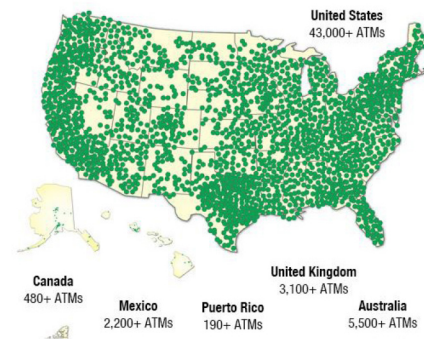

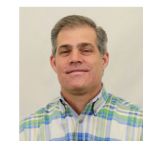
## DATCU Voted Best Place to Work in Texas
